Indiana Manufacturers Association Endorses Zoeller for Attorney General

Indianapolis — Today, the Indiana Manufacturers Association announced, by a unanimous vote of its Board of Directors, its endorsement of Greg Zoeller for election as Attorney General of Indiana.

In a letter to Zoeller, IMA President Patrick J. Kiely said, “We consider the regular protection and support of the law and procedures of the state to be of the utmost importance. We believe that you, Greg Zoeller, are best prepared and disposed to provide that protection and support as attorney general.”

The IMA Board of Directors examined the record of both major party candidates for attorney general. It is on that basis that they cast their votes in unanimous support of endorsing Greg Zoeller, in the sincere belief that his service as attorney general will bring stability to the law in Indiana and help provide the sort of economic climate in which manufacturing businesses can grow and prosper in the immediate future.

The IMA came into existence 107 years ago to support the continuing vitality of manufacturing in the state and advocate an economic climate in which Hoosiers could prosper. To that end, IMA considers this endorsement of Greg Zoeller for Attorney General as critical to achieving that goal.
